SCAVENGER HUNT

Today we are going to participate in a scavenger hunt activity. Here is a list of items and landmarks that we want you to locate and identify. The purpose of this activity is for PHYSICS 209 students to learn a bit more about the Little Village community. Please be careful, be open to learn new things, and have fun. Report back to your car for an on-time departure.

1. What is commonly "missing" in a Mexican bakery? (You'll need to taste the wares to find the answer.)
2. Find the name of the community written in Spanish and take a picture of your group in front of it.
3. Order corn on the cob with toppings of your choice from a street vendor.
4. Find something with a Mexican flag on it.
5. Find and visit a store that sells "botanicals."
6. Visit a grocery store to find:
 - a. a fruit with which you are not familiar
 - b. a meat with which you are not familiar
 - c. napales (check the vegetable section)
7. Find the following store fronts:
 - a. A bridal shop
 - b. A shop selling religious items
 - c. A shop selling artwork
 - d. A shop selling music
8. What is the name and color of a typical drink made with flowers and sold in many street cart stands?
9. Find and describe a mural on the side of a building.
10. Visit a "taqueria" and sample the wares. Report on the nature of the items sold there. (Hint: Head east and look on the north side of the street!)
